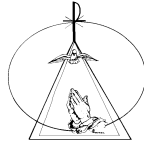

THE DIOCESE OF ORANGE**

AB 654 IS BAD MEDICINE FOR CALIFORNIA

- AB 654 would legalize assisted suicide. It would make assisted suicide a medical treatment.
- AB 654 would give doctors the power to prescribe lethal drug overdoses to patients for the purpose of causing death.
- AB 654 does not require that family members be notified when a doctor is going to help a loved one commit suicide.
- AB 654 would give government health programs, managed care programs and HMOs the opportunity to approve prescriptions for suicide to cut costs.
