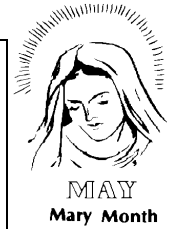

This Sunday, Mother's Day, the Respect Life Committee will honor each mother with a rose after all the Masses to honor motherhood and the gift of life. This year marks the 30th Anniversary of the Life Centers. We salute founder Ruth Rozack and her dedicated care of volunteers, two of whom are Holy Spirit parishioners.

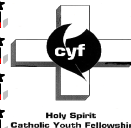
RESPECT LIFE POST CARD CAMPAIGN

The U.S. Supreme Court, in Roe vs. Wade voted into law the "right" to abort our nations children...50 million to date. The right of respect and protection from harm for every human being has been violated. Currently, potential openings on the Supreme Court are prompting the unprecedented use of filibustering any pro-life nominees. Some senators are favoring a pro-abortion litmus test for those nominated who promise to endorse Roe vs. Wade. To oppose this action to determine federal judgeship, U.S. Bishops have called for a post card campaign to contact our senators. Next Sunday, post cards will be made available to sign. The Respect life Committee will stamp and mail them.

In a pilot program started by Bishop Soto, we will also asking for your email addresses. This will keep you informed of future pro-active diocesan activities.

THE GALLERY OF THE SAINTS

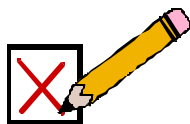

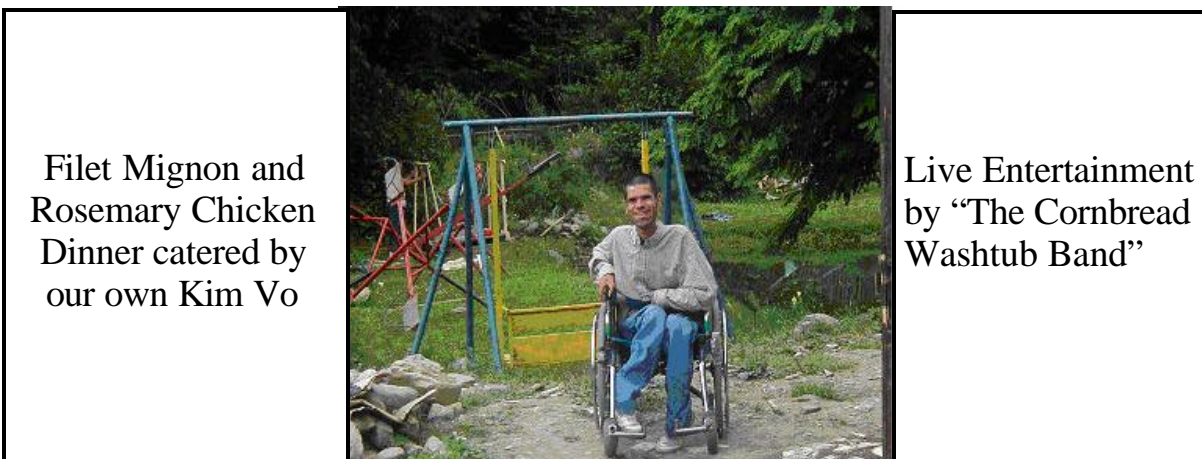
