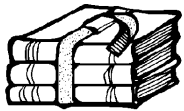

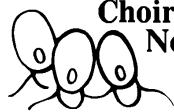
HONORING THE BIRTH OF THE BLESSED MOTHER

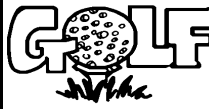

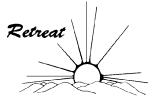
