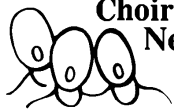
Confirmation Preparation for Youth

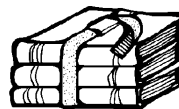


HOLY SPIRIT CATHOLIC YOUTH FELLOWSHIP
