

PARISH MISSION



A Parish Mission is scheduled at Holy Spirit beginning October 22, and running through October 27. The Mission will be given by Fr. Patrick Foley, Ph.D. He is a dynamic speaker and will give the homily at all the English Masses on Saturday, October 22 and Sunday, October 23. Monday through Thursday, he will speak for about an hour after the 9:00 a.m. Mass and then repeat the morning session each evening at 7:30 p.m.

It was brought out at the Pastoral Council Parish Meeting that many parishioners would like greater opportunities for adult education in our Faith. Here is your chance to renew your faith in the Lord and to take some time for yourself before the hectic holiday season. On this the year of the Eucharist, Fr. Foley will highlight our faith in and gratitude for the Eucharist during the Mission.

Though Fr. Foley will only be speaking at the English Masses over the weekend, this Mission is for the **ENTIRE** parish. All parishioners, from young adults to seniors are invited to attend as many sessions as possible during the four days Fr. Foley will be here.

There will be time for fellowship along with light refreshments in Doyle Hall after each morning and evening session.

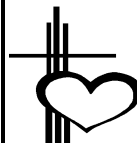

All of us together are better than any one of us alone. Local support is needed for Katrina victims. Our local Catholic Charities, <http://www.ccoc.org/>, is a part of Operation OC which is a collaborative made up of a number of county service organizations. This community response is an effective way for each agency to offer what they are best at to meet the needs of the evacuees. 100 families will be housed at the former Tustin Air Base, Village of Hope. Because of their expertise in counseling and employment services, Catholic Charities has taken on that responsibility. Many of our Catholic schools are also responding by taking in students to ensure that their education is not interrupted.
