A Parish Mission is scheduled at Holy Spirit beginning October 22, and running through October 27. The Mission will be given by Fr. Patrick Foley, Ph.D. He is a dynamic speaker and will give the homily at all the English Masses on Saturday, October 22 and Sunday, October 23. Monday through Thursday, he will speak for about an hour after the 9:00 a.m. Mass and then repeat the morning session each evening at 7:30 p.m.

It was brought out at the Pastoral Council Parish Meeting that many parishioners would like greater opportunities for adult education in our Faith. Here is your chance to renew your faith in the Lord and to take some time for yourself before the hectic holiday season. On this the year of the Eucharist, Fr. Foley will highlight our faith in and gratitude for the Eucharist during the Mission.

Though Fr. Foley will be speaking only at the English Masses over the weekend, this Mission is for the **ENTIRE** parish. All parishioners, from young adults to seniors are invited to attend as many sessions as possible during the four days Fr. Foley will be here.

There will be time for fellowship along with light refreshments in Doyle Hall after each morning and evening session.

There also will be opportunity to celebrate the Sacrament of Reconciliation each weekday. Times will be announced at Masses on Saturday October 22, Sunday October 23, and at each conference.
