

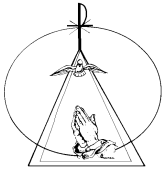

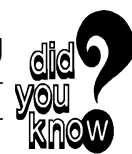

The challenge to be peacemakers:

"In the words of our Holy Father, we need a "moral about face." The whole world must summon the moral courage and technical means to say **"no"** to nuclear conflict; **"no"** to weapons of mass destruction; **"no"** to an arms race which robs the poor and the vulnerable; and **"no"** to the moral danger of a nuclear age which places before humankind indefensible choices of constant terror or surrender. **Peacemaking is not an optional commitment. It is a requirement of our faith. We are called to be peacemakers, not by some movement of the moment, but by our Lord Jesus.** The content and context of our peacemaking is set, not by some political agenda or ideological program, but by the teaching of his Church." (*The Challenge of Peace*, U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops, 1983, par. 333.)
