**A MESSAGE FROM THE DIOCESE**

The Diocese of Orange has been informed that an allegation of sexual misconduct with a minor has been reported against Rev. Gordon Pillon of the Diocese of Peoria. The Bishop of the Diocese of Peoria has placed Fr. Pillon on leave from ministry while the allegation is being investigated.

The allegation relates to conduct which was to have occurred while Fr. Pillon was a priest in the Diocese of Orange. Fr. Pillon served as a priest in the Diocese of Orange from December 1979 to January 1990 at the following parishes:

- Our Lady of Guadalupe, La Habra Dec. 1979—Jan. 1983
- St. Juliana Falconeri, Fullerton Jan. 1983—June 1987
- St. Angela Merici, Brea July 1987—June 1989
- St. Columban, Garden Grove July 1989—Jan. 1990.

Fr. Pillon served as deacon seminarian in following parishes:

- Holy Spirit, Fountain Valley June—Aug. 1978
- St. Hedwig, Los Alamitos Jan.—Dec. 1979.

In January 1990, Fr. Pillon's request to move to the Diocese of Peoria in order to be closer to his family's relocation to the Midwest was granted. He has been serving in that Diocese ever since. This is the first and only allegation of its type brought to the attention of the Diocese of Orange.

Anyone having information of alleged sexual misconduct with minors on the part of Fr. Pillon while he was serving in the Diocese of Orange is encouraged to report to the Diocese of Orange Assistance Ministry Coordinator at 1-800-363-3064 and/or to local law enforcement.

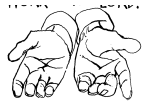

Even though Planned Parenthood uses the RU486 pill for chemical abortions, its New York medical director Hakim Elahi stated that of some 43,000 abortions by this method, 141 women required some surgical intervention anyway, 49 were treated in the ER for heavy bleeding, 20 needed blood transfusions, and 7 were admitted to hospitals for infection. Mr. Elahi further stated that, if he received such a poor report from a surgical abortion clinic, he would recommend that it be immediately shut down.
