IRA ROLLOVER CONTRIBUTIONS

The Pension Protection Act of 2006, signed by the President, created a new option for charitable gifting, but it is available only until the end of 2007.

If you are 70.5 years of age or above, you can donate up to \$100,000 this year directly from your individual retirement account (IRA) to Holy Spirit. The charitable IRA rollover gift is made directly from the IRA custodian to Holy Spirit and is a completely tax-free transfer. This is a great option for those who take the required minimum distribution from their IRA but don't need the additional income.
