As we seek to renew our hearts and minds in preparation for Easter, I would like to invite all of you to participate in the special Lenten activities provided in our parish. Please see the bulletin for a full listing of all activities. Here are a few highlights.

You may wish to consider attending weekday Mass, celebrated daily at 6:30 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. There are men's and women's bible study groups, as well as our YOUTH ministry activities. And Stations of the Cross, a weekly devotion, will be held on Fridays (except Feb. 22) in English at 6:30 p.m., and in Vietnamese at 7:15 p.m. (Vietnamese Mass to follow). This is a special opportunity to pray and walk with Jesus through the Way of the Cross.

To deepen our friendship with one another, please consider the weekly Friday Fish Bakes hosted by our Knights of Columbus. The cost of the dinner is \$8 for adults and \$5 for children and includes a wonderful selection of fish, pasta, and side dishes.

This Lent we are privileged to offer a special benefit concert by Bob Hurd and Anawim commemorating the 20th anniversary of the dedication of our church. They will present "An Evening of Lenten Renewal" on Friday, February 22 at 7:30 p.m. in the church. This is a fundraiser for our Parish, with all proceeds going towards our Building Fund. Suggested ticket donations are: \$10 presale, \$15 at the door, \$5 for students and children under 12 are free. Admission is also free for clergy and religious. Please call the Parish Office for more information. Tickets will be available for purchase after the Masses today, and on the weekends of February 9-10 and 16-17.

**Ash Wednesday and Good Friday** are days of fast as well. To fast means limiting oneself to one full meal and two lighter meals in the course of a day. This obliges Catholics from the ages of 18 to 59.

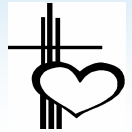
