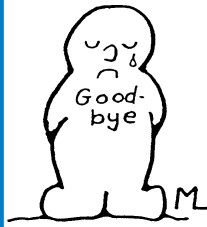

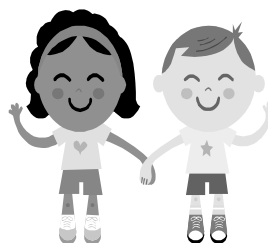

Chúa Nhật 28 tháng 6 năm 2009

**CHÚA NHẬT 13 TNB
SÓNG ĐẠO TIN YÊU VÀ PHÓ THÁC***Mc. 5:21-43*

Cùng với tâm tình tin yêu phó thác và tạ ơn của người phụ nữ và gia đình ông trưởng hội đường trong PA, chúng ta tự nhìn lại đời sống giữ đạo của mình bằng những câu hỏi đơn sơ như: Tương quan đức tin của tôi với Chúa như thế nào? Tôi có cảm nghiệm được thực sự tình yêu giữa tôi với Chúa không? Trong các hoàn cảnh khó nguy cuộc đời, thái độ sống đạo của tôi thế nào trong việc cầu xin và phó thác theo ý Chúa? Sẽ còn rất nhiều những câu hỏi tương tự khác để chúng ta có thể thâm vấn đức tin và tình yêu của mình đối với Ngài. Điều quan trọng hơn trong đời sống đạo vẫn là: Tôi có nhận ra quyền năng và tình yêu Chúa trong đời mình qua mọi biến cố và góc cạnh cuộc sống không? Tôi có thấy sự hiện diện của Chúa bao trùm cuộc sống và vũ trụ này không?

Những câu hỏi ấy có thể sẽ dẫn chúng ta đến những cách chọn lựa để có thể khám phá trực tiếp được quyền năng và tình thương Chúa trong đời mình, chẳng hạn chọn những giây phút yên lặng trầm tĩnh để cầu nguyện một mình trước Thánh Thể, hoặc trong không khí thinh lặng của sa mạc, của biển cả mênh mông, của trời rộng bao la, hay trước sự hùng vĩ của đồi núi thiên nhiên bất tận ... để từ đó nhận ra sự tương quan giữa các chi thể trong thân thể mình, nhận ra tương quan của mình với tha nhân, tương quan của mình với các tạo vật, và cũng từ giây phút cảm nghiệm thánh thiện trong các tương quan ấy, sẽ khám phá và cảm nghiệm được Thiên Chúa và tình yêu sâu thẳm của Ngài ngay trong nội tâm mình.

Cách diễn tả đức tin của người phụ nữ mắc bệnh xuất huyết và của ông trưởng hội đường là cách cảm nghiệm tình thương và quyền năng Chúa hết sức đơn sơ. Quyền năng và tình thương Chúa có sẵn đó, cứ việc chạm đến là tuôn chảy như giòng suối mát ân huệ chữa lành. Việc chạm đến này chính là cuộc gặp gỡ của hai tâm tình yêu thương giữa ta và Chúa, khác hẳn với những cách van xin diễn tả một chiều ý muốn của ta. Và đây cũng là cách thức tốt đẹp nhất trong việc diễn tả niềm tin và tình yêu của chúng ta trong đời sống đạo: sống đạo vì yêu Chúa, từ đó biết phó thác hoàn toàn đời sống chúng ta trong tay Ngài.
